ranthambore

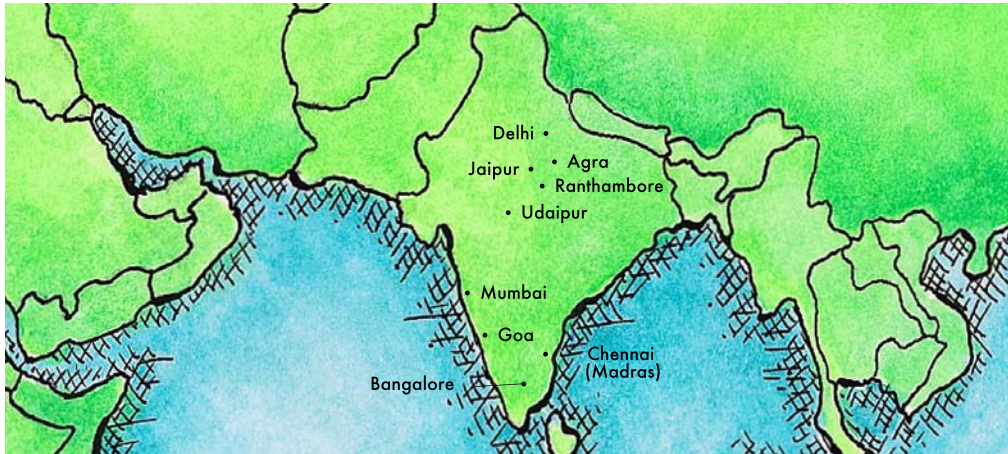
